Preschool: Our highly trained and experienced Early Childhood Educators are committed to supporting children's cognitive & social-emotional development and language learning.

- The only preschool in BC offering instruction in American Sign Language!
- Active play, drama, music, art, poetry, cooking, all with their deaf peers to prepare them for kindergarten and beyond!
- Increase the scope of the program to include collaborations with local parks, farms, aquariums and technology centers to increase the language experience opportunities and community activism experiences for deaf children
 - Expansion of DCS preschool programs to other areas of the province!

Sign Language Instruction: Hearing parents of deaf children require ASL classes and individual instruction to become adequate language models for their children-their future depends on it!

- Expand the number and locations of our Family Group Sign Language Classes-because Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles and cousins count too!
- Expand Sign Language services to remote areas of BC and expand online training and supports for families with the provision of new technology infrastructure
- Support our current in-home sign language lessons for more families
